DR EVELYN LIP is a chartered architect and a specialist consultant in feng shui. She has a PhD and a Masters in Architecture, and taught architecture in the Universities of Malaya and Singapore. Dr Lip began her studies in feng shui and the metaphysics of architecture in the 1970s, and has written over 30 books, all of which exhibit scholarship and in-depth knowledge of the subject. She is also a talented Chinese brush-painting artist and drew all the illustrations in her books.

Dr Evelyn Lip's feng shui books published by Marshall Cavendish have sold over 250,000 copies worldwide (and translated into several languages) since her first book *Chinese Geomancy* was published in 1979. It was the first to be published in English on the ancient science of Chinese geomancy and generated great interest in the art of placement of objects and buildings for harmony. Her other books in the series – *Feng Shui For The Home* (1986), *Feng Shui For Business* (1989) and *Personalise Your Feng Shui* (1997) – have brought feng shui into the psyche of people all over the world. In this updated and revised series, Dr Lip presents new information and analyses the feng shui of several modern-day iconic buildings from around the world.
