JACK AND RAI

Jack & Rai have been the frontmen of EIC since the band was formed in July 2002. Before their first gig as a duo at Wala Wala, they met while performing as soloists on separate nights at local bar Barcelona. A few chance meetings between 2000 and 2002 turned into ad-hoc jam sessions before an audition at Wala Wala started a new chapter in their lives and music careers. Since then, Jack & Rai have been regularly entertaining full-house crowds with their infectious brand of cover songs from the likes of U2, Coldplay, Oasis, Jason Mraz, John Mayer and the Dave Matthews Band. Presently, they are also co-hosts in a radio show on Class 95FM, with Jean Danker.

RJ ROSALES

Best known in Singapore for his role of Chang in the hit musical 'Chang and Eng'. He also appeared in major hit musicals such as 'Cabaret' and 'Forbidden City'. Around the region, RJ's career in the Philippines has also been quite extensive as singer, actor, host, recording artist and celebrity endorser. A familiar face on TV and the concert scene for a number of years, his regular appearance on the hit TV show 'ASAP' made him a household name in the country.

THE ART OF GEOFF TAN

Since the late nineties, self-taught Singaporean artist Geoff Tan has been fascinated by the object of the sunflower. Ever since winning the school's coveted Art Prize while studying "down-under" at Waverley College in Sydney, Geoff has continued to pursue his love for this expression by experimenting with a myriad of subjects including still life, nudes & tribal images.

Across all of these, his specific affinity has been with the sunflower. In his own words, "the sunflower exudes a host of positive reverberations which makes it a happy symbol for us all to adopt as we strive to live life fashioned against a bright demeanour and cheerful disposition".

Geoff's major medium involves the interaction of both acrylic and poster paints expressed inspiringly on canvas boards. Bright and affirmative colours are deliberately used to artistically connote the emotive elements of the subject matter so as to instill a perfect balance of progressive karma within each individual soul.



RUPALI JESWAL

Rupali Jeswal began her indulgence in art began in 1998 when she lived in Vietnam, a self-taught artist who dares to bring life on to the canvas using mixed-media of all sorts and sometimes obliterating the need of brushes and just using her hands and knives. She has supported various foundations for tribal communities, orphanages and AIDS/HIV hospice in Thailand & India. Her perception is not a statement, it is a continuous process for refinement through input from others. To bring out the extraordinary of an ordinary sight or thought is the challenge she loves to delve in.



CALE CHEW

Cale Chew is a self-taught artist. Creating a unique contemporary style that combines both realism and a cartoon character, Cale paints from inspiration based on quotations so every painting has a story behind it. Her work usually bright and colourful in water-colour with mixed medium, is a celebration of peace, friendship and love of nature. Despite being a new kid on the block, she was invited by Singapore Soka Association to produce a calendar featuring 12 of her works in aid for their new building fund last year. She hopes to use her artwork to encourage and inspire others.
